Liberty urges the Council to agree that Liberty's policy should be to challenge the use of 'online harms' as a basis for regulating speech online and to focus on the threat to free expression and equality posed by the use of this and other vague and overbroad sub-categories of harm.

POSITION REACHED

Council endorsed the paper and noted that the paper acknowledged that some speech is harmful and free speech protections are not absolute as a matter of law, leaving open space for Liberty to consider some form of appropriate regulation, as suggested by several members of Council.
